

Pleasant Valley Swim Team Presents the 3rd Annual Pirate Meet / Last Chance JO Qualifier

DATE OF MEET:	Saturday and Sunday, July 19-20, 2008
SANCTIONED BY:	Southern California Swimming, USA Swimming
SANCTION #:	08-153
STARTING TIME:	A.M. Session: 9 a.m. (Check in/Warmup at 7:30 a.m.) P.M. Session: Will not start prior to 12:00pm. Check-in/warmup 45 min prior to start.
ENTRY DEADLINE:	Postmarked by Monday, July 7, 2008 or hand delivered by Wednesday, July 9 5:00pm. No late entries will be accepted. Entries will be limited to meet the 4-hour rule. Entries postmarked by July 7, 2008, take priority over hand delivered entries received July 8 th or 9 th , 2008.
LOCATION:	Ventura College Aquatic Center , 4667 Telegraph Rd., Ventura, CA. 101 freeway to Ventura; exit Victoria Ave North. Left on Telegraph Rd. Right on West Campus Road.
COURSE:	Long Course – Pool is an outdoor 50m x 25y pool with 8 lanes. Glass containers and food are not allowed in pool area! No pets allowed in the pool area!
WARM-UP:	Swimmers warming up or down before, during and after the meet must be under the direct supervision of a current 2008 USA Swimming coach. Warm up rules will be announced and enforced. No diving into the pool except for the sprint lanes as directed by the Meet Referee. Marshals will be designated to oversee the warm-up procedure and pool.
CHECK-IN:	Swimmers must check in with the Clerk of Course for each event they wish to swim. After an event has been officially closed, swimmers MAY NOT CHECK IN OR SCRATCH. Swimmers in the first 4 events each session must check in at least 20 minutes prior to the start of the meet. Swimmers who check in and fail to swim an event will be scratched from their next individual event. Swimmers must swim in their actual age group as determined by age on the first day of the meet.
RULES:	USA Swimming rules will govern. Current SCS meet procedures will be used and take precedence over any errors or omissions in this form. The Meet Referee will be in charge of the meet. Any questions regarding the conduct of the meet should be directed to that person.
OPEN EVENTS:	Swimmers must be at least 11 years old, and have previously achieved the minimum time standard for the event in a meet.
SWIMWEAR:	The swimsuits worn in SCS age group events shall conform to USA Swimming Rule 102.9 and shall not extend past the top of the shoulder (acromial process) nor further down the leg than the top of the knee (patella).
ELIGIBILITY:	Open to Coastal Section and Out of District swimmers (priority will be given to Coastal swimmers if limiting entries is required). Registration application must be received by meet host or SCS office prior to the first day of the meet. REGISTRATION APPLICATION MAY BE SUBMITTED TOGETHER WITH ENTRY FORM. There are substantial penalties to swimmer and Club (see SCS Swim Guide, Part One, III, B) if registration is completed at meet.
CHANGE OF AFFILIATION:	Before the meet, a swimmer may change his/her affiliation by submitting a Club Transfer Form and appropriate fee to the Swim Office. At the meet, a swimmer may only unattach (not attach or reattach) by notifying the Administrative Referee in writing and paying the appropriate fee.
SUBMITTED & QUALIFYING TIMES:	Submit your best recorded LONG course meter times from this or preceding swim season (not practice or estimated times). Do not submit NT (no time) or ET (estimated time) except for White division entries. If a swimmer does not have a recorded time but is otherwise qualified, swimmer may enter at minimum (see Swim Guide for exceptions). Please make sure your entry times are correct. SWIMMERS ARE LIMITED TO FOUR (4) INDIVIDUAL EVENTS PER DAY.
ENTRY PROCEDURE:	Submit one SCS consolidated entry card per swimmer to enter this meet. Card must be filled out completely including entire USA Swimming registration number.
ELECTRONIC ENTRY	E-mail entry (entry .zip file) will be accepted only when received with an attached Word or .pdf file including electronic signature of coach and will be dated as official at that time.(5PM postmark would queue before a 10PM electronic). Full payment (single team check) for an e-mail entry must be postmarked within 48 hours of the e-mail entr. Failure to comply will be referred to the Board of Review. Entry updates (added events) will be processed when received by the processor by the entry deadline. Added events (entered swimmers) may be submitted by hardcopy (this includes e-mail) ONLY. New swimmers accepted SPACE AVAILABLE. DO NOT RESEND AN ENTRY FILE: A replacement file for the team will NOT be processed. Deletions will NOT be refunded.
FEE:	\$2.75 per INDIVIDUAL EVENT, plus a \$5.50 surcharge PER SWIMMER. A check for the total amount must accompany each entry to the address below (NOT THE SWIM OFFICE). You should enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope or postcard to confirm receipt of your entry. NO REFUNDS. RETURNED CHECKS WILL INCUR A SERVICE FEE PER SCS POLICY.
AWARDS:	Blue, Red, White Divisions: Ribbons 1 st thru 6 th places for swimmers 12 and under. 8 & under and 9-10 will be awarded separately.
